# It's simple to get the right fit

Before cutting your stoma template for the first time, watch our video guide to creating a new template and follow the instructions below.

### Determine the size and shape of your stoma

Use the backing paper from your current stoma bag and place this over your stoma. You should be able to see 1mm of skin around the stoma. If this is the case, the template is accurate. You can use a mirror to check.

If the backing paper is touching your stoma (too small) or if there is more than 1mm of skin showing around the stoma (too big), you need to change your template.




#### Cut and check

Cut the template opposite out as carefully as you can, preferably using stoma bag scissors if you have them, or a sharp pair of scissors. Check this against your stoma. If it is snug, this is your new template.
